  - Malaysia Airlines MH 765 departing Siem Reap at 1300 on 31<sup>st</sup> Jan 08 (Thur)

## How much does it cost?

- Airline tickets
  - Silkair (Singapore-Phnom Penh; Siem Reap-Singapore) – SGD\$709 (incl taxes)
  - Jetstar (Singapore-Phnom Penh; Siem Reap-Singapore) – SGD\$186 (incl taxes)
  - AirAsia (Kuala Lumpur-Phnom Penh; Siem Reap-Kuala Lumpur) – RM\$369 (incl taxes)
  - Malaysia Airlines (Kuala Lumpur-Phnom Penh; Siem Reap-Kuala Lumpur) – RM\$2660 (incl taxes)
- Accommodation – USD\$18 per night (twin-share with air-conditioning)
- Food – USD\$1.50 per meal
- Entry and exit visa – USD\$25 each

## Preparations required?

- Spiritual:
  - Pray, pray and pray! (Phil 4:6-7)
  - Keep close to God through daily devotions and quiet time (Ps 119:9-16)
  - Be well equipped with His Word (2 Tim 2:15)
  - Learn and be able to teach Christian songs
  - Brothers – Be prepared to deliver God’s Word (1 Pet 4:11)
  - Sisters – Be ready for Sunday School teaching (Heb 5:12)
  - Collect and bring over useful Bible Study / Sunday School materials
  
- Physical:
  - Keep up to date with your immunisations
    - <http://www.cdc.gov/travel/seasia.htm>
    - Recommended vaccinations – Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Typhoid and booster shots for tetanus-diphtheria, polio and measles, mumps and rubella
    - Malaria preventative medications
      - Chloroquine or Mefloquine – to be commenced 1 week before arrival and 4 weeks after departure
      - OR doxycycline for G6PD-deficient people
  
- Packing List:
  - Travel documents:
    - Bring 4 passport photos
    - Passport
    - Make 2 copies each of your passport identification page, airline tickets, driver’s license and credit cards which you plan to bring along
    - Pack 1 set of copies away from your valuables
  - Clothes:
    - Light-weight cotton
    - Short-sleeved and long-sleeved (for evenings) tops
    - Long-sleeved pants
    - Comfortable walking shoes & sandals
  - Insect repellent
  - Sunscreen and sunglasses
  - Personal toiletries and medications

- Flashlight
- Collect and bring over usable stationary
- Collect and bring over useful language textbooks
